- meeting presided over by WSNA President Rick Henterly, 18 people in attendance
- reviewed action items discussed during the September meeting including scheduling monthly speakers for our West Salem meetings, and Adrian Smith's ongoing discussions with the city regarding Washington Park access from Granville and Hutton
- Brice provided a thorough update on the status of the traffic committee's progress - in short, the city has limited budget and staff to address our concerns and only the committee's ongoing and frequent communications will result in positive progress
- Brice also suggested canvassing the neighborhood to document Duke Power light outages. He'll bring sign ups to the November meeting for small teams to address this significant. Safety concern
- Salem Bottling's Jared Roger's provided an update on grand opening schedule, progress and plans, and spoke to parking concerns. It was agreed by all present that all local businesses (East of Texas, Lesser Known, etc) in that area need to work together to ensure adequate parking and safe pedestrian access.
- a summary of multiple neighborhood homes being cited with code violations was presented. We will have our local code enforcer attend an upcoming meeting to share what standards all residences are held to for consistency.
- by-laws update will be led by Brice with progress expected to be presented at November meeting.
